EUROPA FILM TREASURES COMPETITION RULES

Article 1: ORGANISATION

The companies

Lobster Films, S.A.S. with a capital of €150,600 registered with the Trade Register of Paris under the number B 332 815 224 with its headquarters 13 rue Lacharrière 75011 Paris France.

Enki Technologies, Sarl with a capital of €40,000 registered with the Trade Register of Paris under the number B 413159385 with its headquarters 13 rue Raymond Losserand 75014 Paris France.

Hereafter called "host companies" are organising a free game on the Internet with no obligation to buy. The game begins on the 22nd December 2009 and will end the 31st December 2011 included.

Article 2: PARTICIPATION TERMS

This game is open to all natural people over the age of 18 with Internet access and a valid e-mail address, with the exception of members of staff of the host companies and members of their respective families.

The participants access the game via websites <http://www.europafilmtreasures.fr>, <http://www.europafilmtreasures.eu>, <http://www.europafilmtreasures.com>, and notably to addresses <http://concours.europafilmtreasures.fr>, <http://concours.europafilmtreasure.eu>. Links, announcing the game, could be found on partner websites of host companies.

Taking part in the game involves full and entire acceptance of the present game rules and principles on the part of the Internet users. Any problems in applying or interpreting the rules will be defined by the host companies and no appeal can be made.

Article 3: GAME PRINCIPLE

To take part in the game, the Internet user must fill in a participation form with his/her personal details then either:

- answer 1 multiple choice question. To validate his/her participation, he/she must correctly answer the question,
- answer 1 open question.

The participant has the chance to increase his/her individual chances in the draw. For this he/she is invited to inform people he/she knows of the existence of the game to suggest they play. The participant must then fill in a form giving up to five e-mail addresses of friends. The e-mail address filled in must all be different from one another.

Each participant must fill in the form with the following compulsory fields: e-mail address, surname, first name, town and country. He/she must also indicate if he/she wishes to subscribe to the Europa Film Treasures newsletter or not by ticking the box provided for this purpose.

The period during which Internet users will have the chance to take part in the game will be from the 22/12/2009 to the 31/12/2011 included. During this period prizes will be awarded at time intervals at the discretion of the host companies.

For each game period, the winning participants will be designated winners in one of the following ways (a single subscription per participant is authorised during the duration of each game):

- a draw carried out in the premises of one of the host companies that will designate the winners among the Internet users who validated their participation,
- a selection by a panel made up of 3 people named by the host companies for the open question. The people taking part in the decision meeting will not have been able to take part in the competition themselves, nor a member of their family or company.

Article 4: GIFTS

The designated winning participants will receive, of the host companies' own choosing and according to the game sessions, a DVD, a DVD boxed set, a book, a CD, a ticket for a show, a cinema entry of a value between €15 inclusive of tax and €60 inclusive of tax.

The above-mentioned prizes cannot be subject to a request for financial compensation, an exchange or a return for any reason whatsoever. No refund of any kind will be allowed. The host companies reserve the right to substitute a prize of an equivalent value or similar characteristics for one of the suggested prizes at any time.

The winners' surnames, first names and town will be published on the game website for a duration at the organisers' discretion.

The winners will be personally informed of their win by the host companies by e-mail to the e-mail address given in the game participation form. They will have 15 days from receiving this e-mail to respond by confirming their acceptance of the prize and their full postal address.

Host companies will not be held responsible in the event of the non-delivery of the e-mail announcing the win following a mistake in the e-mail address given by the participant in his/her game participation form, in the event of a failure by the service provider, in the event of an internet network failure or for any other reason.

Any winner who does not answer within 15 days will be considered to have purely and simply renounced his/her prize. The prize will not be attributed and can on no account be claimed at a later date. It will remain the property of the host companies.

The winners' choice of residence is the address given and confirmed. The host companies will not be held responsible for delays and/or losses during transport due to the postal services or carriers, nor the total or partial destruction of prizes by this type of transport or in the event of the poor running of these services or for any other reason.

Any prize that could not be distributed following an error or omission in the participants' address, or a modification of this address or for any other reason will be kept by the host companies.

Article 5: LIABILITY LIMIT

The game can be cancelled or postponed for a case of force majeure or other reasons independent of the host companies' volition without them being held responsible or any recourse brought to bear on them.

The date of the draws is given for information only. It is likely to be changed if circumstances require it, with no notice required or any complaint being made to the host companies.

Article 6: REFUND OF PARTICIPATION EXPENSES

As the competition is without obligation to buy, the host companies cannot be asked for any refund of expenses of any kind.

Article 7: FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT

In accordance with the law n° 78-17 of the 6th January 1978 relating to freedom of information, participants registered with the competition have rights to oppose (art. 26), access (art. 34 to 38), rectify and delete (art. 36) personal data concerning them. Article 8: RULE REGISTRATION AND ACCEPTANCE

These rules are governed by French law. Any participation leads to the present rules being accepted in their entirety as well as the decision of the host companies regarding any protest that could arise concerning the interpretation and application of the present rules.
